BY THE BLESSINGS OF ALMIGHTY GOD

THE REGENT OF GRESIK,

Considering: a. that in order to realize the concern of the Gresik Regency Regional Government towards the burden of the community affected by the death disaster, the Gresik Regency Government provides Death Benefits to their heirs, the implementation of which is regulated by Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 74 of 2011 on the Granting of Death Benefits for the Poor in the Regency of Gresik, as amended twice by Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 43 of 2013;

b. that to ensure legal certainty and justice for the community, with the enactment of the Integrated Data of the Poverty Alleviation Program in accordance with the Decree of the Minister of Social Affairs Number 32/HUK/2016 on the Determination of Integrated Data of the Poverty Alleviation Program as data used by the Gresik Regency Government in determining the target of social protection programs, it is necessary to adjust the provisions of the poor community considered eligible to receive death benefit assistance as stipulated in the Regents Regulation as referred to in letter a; c. that based on the considerations referred to in letter a and letter b, it is necessary to issue a Regents Regulation on the Third Amendment to Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 74 of

2011 on the Granting of Death Benefits for the Poor in the Regency of Gresik;

Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 13 of 2006 on Guidelines for Regional Financial Management, as amended several times lastly by Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 21 of 2011 on the Second Amendment to Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 13 of 2006 (State News of the Republic of Indonesia of 2011 Number 310);

Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 32 of 2011 on Guidelines for Granting Grants and Social Assistance sourced from the Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget (State News of the Republic of Indonesia of 2011 Number 450) as amended several times lastly by Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 14 of 2016 on the Second Amendment to Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 32 of 2011 on Guidelines for Granting Grants and Social Assistance Sourced from the Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget (State News of the Republic of Indonesia of 2016 Number 541);

8. Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 80 of 2015 on the Formation of Regional Legal Products (State News of the Republic of Indonesia of 2015 Number 2036);

9. Decree of the Minister of Social Affairs Number: 32/HUK/2016 on the Determination of Integrated Data of the Poverty Alleviation Program;
10. Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 74 of 2011 on the Granting of Death Benefits for the Poor in the Regency of Gresik (Regional Gazette of Gresik Regency of 2011 Number 937) as amended several times lastly by Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 43 of 2013 on the Second Amendment to Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 74 of 2011 on the Granting of Death Benefits for the Poor in the Regency of Gresik (Regional Gazette of Gresik Regency of 2013 Number 1465);

DECIDES:

To Enact: REGULATION OF THE REGENT ON THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO REGULATION OF THE REGENT OF GRESIK NUMBER 74 OF 2011 ON THE GRANTING OF DEATH BENEFITS FOR THE POOR IN THE REGENCY OF GRESIK.

Article I

Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 74 of 2011 on the Granting of Death Benefits for the Poor in the Regency of Gresik (Regional Gazette of Gresik Regency of 2011 Number 937) which has been amended several times by Regulation of the Regent of Gresik:

- a. Number 27 of 2012 (Regional Gazette of Gresik Regency of 2012 Number 542);
- b. Number 43 of 2013 (Regional Gazette of Gresik Regency of 2013 Number 1465); is amended as follows:

- 1. The provisions of Article 1, are amended to read as follows:

Article 1

In this Regulation:

1. Region means the Regency of Gresik.
2. Regent means the Regent of Gresik.
3. Regional Government means the Head of Region and other regional apparatus as implementing elements of the regional government.
4. Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget, hereinafter referred to as APBD, means an annual regional plan determined based on the Regional Regulation on the Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget.
5. Resident means Indonesian Citizens and Foreigners residing in Indonesia.
6. Residents of Gresik Regency, hereinafter referred to as Residents, means Regional Citizens domiciled in Gresik.
7. Poor People of Gresik Regency, hereinafter referred to as poor people, means individuals residing in Gresik with a Family Card and Identity Card of Gresik Regency, and included in the Integrated Data of the Poverty Alleviation Program.
8. Death Benefit means a contribution in the form of money given to heirs to alleviate the burden on the bereaved family.
9. Heirs means husband, wife, children and blood relatives.

2. The provisions in Article 8 section (3) letter e, letter f, and letter g, are amended and section (3A) and section (6) are deleted so that Article 8 reads as follows:

#### Article 8

- (1) To obtain death benefit funds, heirs must submit a letter of application to the Regent through the Sub-district Head.
- (2) The application letter is sent by the Sub-district Head after being verified by the Head of the Technical Implementation Team for the Distribution of Death Benefit Social Assistance in the Sub-district.
- (2A) The application referred to in section (1) is processed by the Peoples Welfare Administration Section.
- (3) The Application Letter referred to in section (2) must be accompanied by:

- a. A death certificate from the local village head/head of sub-district;
- b. A photocopy of the Gresik Identity Card and Gresik Family Card from the applicant/heir;
- c. Deleted;
- d. A photocopy of the Birth Certificate or birth certificate from a midwife/birth certificate from the village/sub-district (triplicate) and a photocopy of the parents marriage certificate for underage citizens;
- e. A Certificate from the Village Head/Sub-district Head stating that the deceased is included in the Integrated Data of the Poverty Alleviation Program;
- f. A photocopy of the Integrated Data sheet of the Poverty Alleviation Program where the deceased is listed and legalized by the Village Head/Sub-district Head;
- g. Deleted.

(3A) Deleted.

(4) Heirs may authorize someone to submit an application with a sufficiently stamped power of attorney.

(5) For Applicants who are authorized, the authorized recipient must sign a statement that the documents attached are true and legally accountable.

(6) Deleted.

## Article II

This Regents Regulation shall come into force on the date of its promulgation.

In order for everyone to know, it is ordered that this Regents Regulation be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Gresik Regency.

(1) The requirements for the completeness of the application letter to obtain death benefit funds, determined based on the provisions in Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 74 of 2011 on the Granting of Death Benefits for the Poor in Gresik Regency, as amended by Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 27 of 2012 and amended by Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 43 of 2013, remain valid until December 31, 2016.

(2) The requirements for the completeness of the application letter to obtain death benefit funds, as determined based on the provisions in this Regents Regulation, shall apply from January 1, 2017.
