THE POLICY AND STRATEGY OF THE REGENCY OF GRESIK IN THE MANAGEMENT OF
HOUSEHOLD WASTE AND WASTE SIMILAR TO HOUSEHOLD WASTE

BY THE BLESSINGS OF ALMIGHTY GOD

THE REGENT OF GRESIK,

Considering: that in order to implement the provisions of Article 7 section (5) of Presidential Regulation Number 97 of 2017 on the National Policy and Strategy for the Management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste, it is necessary to issue a Regent Regulation on the Policy and Strategy of the Regency of Gresik in the Management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;

Considering: 1. Law Number 23 of 2014 on Regional Government (State Gazette of 2014 Number 244, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 5587) as amended several times, lastly by Law Number 9 of 2015 on the Second Amendment to Law Number 23 of 2014 on Regional Government (State Gazette of 2015 Number 58, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 5679);

2. Government Regulation Number 81 of 2012 on the Management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste (State Gazette of 2012 Number 188, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 5347); 3. Presidential Regulation Number 97 of 2017 on the National Policy and Strategy for the Management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2017 Number 223);

4. Regulation of the Minister of Environment and Forestry Number:

P.10/MENLHK/SETJEN/PLB.0/4/2018 on Guidelines for the Preparation of Regional Policies and Strategies for the Management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste (State News of the Republic of Indonesia of 2018 Number 734);

8. Regulation of the Regent of Gresik Number 53 of 2016 on the Position, Organizational Structure, Duties, Functions, and Work Procedures of the Gresik Regency Environmental Agency (Regional Gazette of the Regency of Gresik of 2016 Number 737);

DECIDES:

To enact: THE REGENT REGULATION ON THE POLICY AND STRATEGY OF THE REGENCY OF GRESIK IN THE MANAGEMENT OF HOUSEHOLD WASTE AND WASTE SIMILAR TO HOUSEHOLD WASTE.

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

In this Regent Regulation:

1. Household Waste means waste originating from daily activities in households, excluding feces and specific waste.
2. Waste Similar to Household Waste means Household Waste originating from commercial areas, industrial areas, special areas, social facilities, public facilities, and/or other facilities.
3. Waste Source means the origin of waste generation.
4. Central Government means the President of the Republic of Indonesia who holds the power of the Government of the Republic of Indonesia, assisted by the Vice President and ministers as referred to in the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia.
5. Regional Government means the Head of Region as an element of the Regional Government organizer who leads the implementation of government affairs that are the authority of the autonomous region.
6. National Policy and Strategy for the Management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste, hereinafter referred to as Jakstranas, means the policy direction and strategy in the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste at the national level that is integrated and sustainable.
7. Regional Policy and Strategy for the Management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste, hereinafter referred to as Jakstrada, means the policy direction and strategy in the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste at the Provincial and Regency/City regional levels that is integrated and sustainable.
8. Minister means the minister who manages environmental affairs.
9. Governor means the Governor of East Java.
10. Regent means the Regent of Gresik.
11. Region means the Regency of Gresik.

CHAPTER II

JAKSTRADA DIRECTION

Section One

General

Article 2

(1) Jakstrada includes:

- a. Policy direction for the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste; and
- b. Strategies, programs, and targets for the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste.

(2) Jakstrada as referred to in section (1) is implemented in the period from 2018 to 2025.

Section Two

Policy Direction for the Reduction and Handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste

Article 3

(1) The policy direction for the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in Article 2 section (1) letter a includes improving performance in the fields of:

- a. reduction of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste; and
- b. handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste.

(2) The reduction of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in section (1) letter a is carried out through:

- a. limiting the generation of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;
- b. reusing Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste; and/or
- c. recycling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste.

(3) The handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in section (1) letter b is carried out through:

- a. sorting;
- b. collection;
- c. transportation;
- d. processing; and
- e. final processing.

Section Three

Strategies, Targets, and Programs for the Reduction and Handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste

Article 4

(1) The strategy for reducing Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in Article 2 section (1) letter b includes:

- a. implementation of norms, standards, procedures, and criteria in reducing Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;
- b. strengthening coordination and cooperation between the Central Government and Regional Governments;
- c. strengthening the commitment of executive and legislative bodies in the region in providing a budget for the reduction of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;
- d. increasing the capacity of leadership, institutions, and human resources in efforts to reduce Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;
- e. establishing an information system;

- f. strengthening community involvement through communication, information, and education;
- g. implementing and developing incentive and disincentive systems in reducing Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste; and
- h. strengthening the commitment of the business world through the implementation of producer obligations in reducing Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste.

(2) The strategy for handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in Article 2 section (1) letter b includes:

- a. implementation of norms, standards, procedures, and criteria in handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;
- b. strengthening coordination and cooperation between the Central Government and Regional Governments;
- c. strengthening the commitment of executive and legislative bodies in the region in providing a budget for handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;
- d. increasing the capacity of leadership, institutions, and human resources in handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste;
- e. establishing an information system;
- f. strengthening community involvement through communication, information, and education;
- g. implementing and developing investment, operational, and maintenance schemes;
- h. strengthening law enforcement;
- i. strengthening the involvement of the business world through partnerships with the Central Government;
- j. applying environmentally friendly and appropriate technology for handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste; and
- k. implementing and developing incentive and disincentive systems in handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste.

Article 5

(1) The targets for the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household

Waste as referred to in Article 2 section (1) letter b include:

- a. reduction of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste by 30% (thirty percent) of the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste generated before the national policy and strategy for the reduction of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste in 2025; and
- b. handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste by 70% (seventy percent) of the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste generated before the national policy and strategy for handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste in 2025.

(2) The targets for the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in section (1) are listed in Appendix I, which is an inseparable part of this Regent Regulation.

Article 6

Jakstrada as referred to in Articles 2 to 5 is implemented through programs as listed in Appendix II, which is an inseparable part of this Regent Regulation.

CHAPTER III

IMPLEMENTATION OF JAKSTRADA

Section One

General

Article 7

(1) Jakstrada is in line with the long-term development plan of the Regency of Gresik and the medium-term development plan of the Regency of Gresik.

(2) The preparation of Jakstrada as referred to in section (1), in addition to being guided by Jakstranas, is also guided by the Provincial Jakstrada.

Section Two

Jakstrada

Article 8

(1) In the implementation of Jakstrada, the Regent, in accordance with his/her authority, is tasked with:

- a. implementing Jakstrada and coordinating the implementation of Jakstrada;
- b. carrying out monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of Jakstrada;
- c. submitting the results of the implementation of Jakstrada to the Governor at least once a year.

(2) The Regent is responsible for the procurement of land, facilities, and infrastructure for the management of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste in accordance with the provisions of applicable regulations.

Article 9

(1) The monitoring as referred to in Article 8 section (1) letter b is carried out to obtain information on the achievements of the reduction and handling of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste.

(2) The achievement of the reduction of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in section (1) is measured using the following indicators:

- a. the amount of decrease in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste generated per capita;

- b. the amount of increase in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste recycled at the Waste Source; and
- c. the amount of increase in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste reused at the Waste Source.

(3) The achievement of handling Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste as referred to in section (1) is measured using the following indicators:

- a. the amount of increase in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste sorted at the Waste Source;
- b. the amount of decrease in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste transported to the final processing site;
- c. the amount of increase in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste transported to the Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste processing center to become raw materials and/or energy sources;
- d. the amount of increase in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste processed into raw materials;
- e. the amount of increase in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste utilized as an energy source; and
- f. the amount of decrease in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste processed at the final processing site.

(4) The results of the monitoring as referred to in sections (2) and (3) are compiled in the form of a Jakstrada report.

(5) An evaluation of the Jakstrada report as referred to in section (4) is carried out, coordinated by the Regent through:

- a. comparison between achievement and planning targets; and
- b. identification and resolution of implementation obstacles.

(6) The results of the evaluation are used as a basis for improving Jakstrada.

CHAPTER IV

FUNDING

Article 10

Funding for the implementation of Jakstrada can come from the Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget and other legitimate funding sources in accordance with the provisions of applicable regulations.

CHAPTER V

FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 11

This Regent Regulation comes into force on the date of its enactment.

In order for everyone to know, this Regent Regulation is ordered to be enacted by placing it in the Regional Gazette of the Regency of Gresik.
