THE REGENT OF GRESIK

Considering: a. That as a Foundation and Guideline for the implementation of Regional Development of the Regency of Gresik, which is an integral part and united with the Provincial Development of East Java and National Development, it is deemed necessary to establish a Basic Pattern of Regional Development which is also a logical elaboration of the Broad Outlines of State Policy as stipulated in the MPR Decree Number II/MPR/1993;

b. That the implementation of PELITA V has yielded positive results and has been able to create a fairly stable situation; therefore, to provide clarity of direction and guidance for the implementation of the harmony and consistency of Regional Development with Provincial Development of East Java and National Development gradually and continuously, it is necessary to have a Basic Pattern of Regional Development of the Regency of Gresik for the years 1994/1995 - 1998/1999, to be established by Regional Regulation.

Considering: 1. The Decree of the Peoples Consultative Assembly of the Republic of Indonesia Number II/MPR/1993 on the Broad Outlines of State Policy;

2. Law Number 5 of 1974 on the Principles of Regional Government;
3. Law Number 12 of 1950 on the Formation of Regencies within the Province of East Java; Law Number 2 of 1965 on the Change of the Boundary Area of the Municipality of Surabaya and the Regency of Surabaya;
4. Law Number 4 of 1982 on Provisions for Environmental Management;
5. Law Number 5 of 1990 on the Conservation of Biological Natural Resources and Their Ecosystems;
6. Law Number 24 of 1992 on Spatial Planning;
7. Government Regulation Number 38 of 1974 on the Change of Name of Surabaya Regency to Gresik Regency;
8. Presidential Decree of the Republic of Indonesia Number 27 of 1980 on the Formation of the Regional Development Planning Agency;
9. Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 14 of 1974 on the Form of Regional Regulations;
10. Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 9 of 1982 on Guidelines for the Preparation of Planning and Control of Development in Regions;
11. Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 5 of 1993 on Guidelines for the Preparation of the Basic Pattern of Regional Development;
12. Decree of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 185 of 1980 on Guidelines for the Organization

and Work Procedures of the Provincial Regional Development Planning Agency and the Regency Regional Development Planning Agency.

To Establish: REGIONAL REGULATION OF THE REGENCY OF GRESIK

ON THE BASIC PATTERN OF REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE REGENCY OF GRESIK FOR THE YEARS 1994/1995 ? 1998/1999.

Section 1

In this Regional Regulation:

- a. GBHN means the Broad Outlines of State Policy as stipulated in the Decree of the Peoples Consultative Assembly of the Republic of Indonesia Number II/MPR/1993.
- b. Region means the Regency of Gresik.
- c. Regional Government means the Government of the Regency of Gresik.
- d. Head of Region means the Regent of Gresik.
- e. Regency DPRD means the Regional House of Representatives of the Regency of Gresik.
- f. Vertical Institution means the Central Government Apparatus at the Regency of Gresik level.
- g. Basic Pattern of Regional Development means the Basic Pattern of Regional Development of the

Regency of Gresik.

h. REPELITA means the Five-Year Development Plan.

i. PELITA means the Five-Year Development.

j. REPELITADA means the Five-Year Regional Development Plan.

k. Gresik Regency means the Regency of Gresik.

l. East Java Province means the Province of East Java.

m. GERBANGKERTOSUSILA means the acronym for Gresik, Bangkalan, Mojokerto, Surabaya, Sidoarjo, and Lamongan.

n. Area means the Area of the Gresik Regency.

o. Sub-district means the District located within the Gresik Regency Area.

Section 2

(1) The Basic Pattern of Regional Development is the main policies of Regional Development encompassing Long-Term Development and the sixth Five-Year Development of the region.

(2) The Basic Pattern of Regional Development referred to in section (1) of this Section is compiled with the following systematics:

CHAPTER I: Introduction

CHAPTER II: Regional Development

CHAPTER III: Second Long-Term Regional Development

CHAPTER IV: Sixth Five-Year Regional Development

CHAPTER V: Implementation

CHAPTER VI: Conclusion.

Section 3

(1) The Basic Pattern of Regional Development referred to in section (2) of this Regional Regulation is an elaboration of the Basic Pattern of Regional Development of East Java Province, after considering the conditions, potential, and aspirations of the community that grow and develop in the Region and serves as a basis for the preparation of REPELITADA.

(2) The material and detailed description of this Basic Pattern of Regional Development are included in the appendix, which is an inseparable part of this Regional Regulation.

Section 4

The Head of Region is obliged to implement the Basic Pattern of Regional Development, to prepare and establish the sixth REPELITA of the Region, guided by this Regional Regulation.

Section 5

This Regional Regulation comes into force on the date of its promulgation.

In order that everyone may be aware of it, the promulgation of this Regional Regulation is ordered with its placement in the Regional Gazette of the Regency of Gresik.

OF THE REGIONAL REGULATION OF THE REGENCY OF GRESIK

NUMBER 6 OF 1994

ON

THE BASIC PATTERN OF REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE REGENCY OF GRESIK FOR THE YEARS 1994/1995 ? 1998/1999

I. GENERAL EXPLANATION

This Regional Regulation document contains two parts: the part that constitutes provisions or articles and the part containing the material of the Basic Pattern of Regional Development as an Appendix to this Regional Regulation. The Basic Pattern of Regional Development of the Regency of Gresik is compiled based on the Decree of the Peoples Consultative Assembly of the Republic of Indonesia Number: II/MPR/1993 on the Broad Outlines of State Policy, guided by the Basic Pattern of Regional Development of East Java Province after considering the conditions, potential, and aspirations of the community growing and developing in the Region.

The purpose of this Basic Pattern of Regional Development is to serve as a guideline and basis for the preparation of Regional Development programs for the period from 1994/1995 to 1998/1999, which is called the sixth Five-Year Development Plan (REPELITA) of the Gresik Regency.

Based on the provisions of Article 5 of Presidential Decree of the Republic of Indonesia Number 27 of 1980 concerning the Formation of the Regional Development Planning Agency, which states that in carrying out its functions, BAPPEDA has the task of, among other things, compiling the Basic Pattern of Strategic Development. Regional Development is development carried out in the Region, encompassing sectoral and regional scopes that mutually support and complement each other and are utilized by the community in the Region.

This Gresik Regional Development includes all development activities carried out in the Gresik Regency, regardless of the source of funding. This reflects the aspirations of the people of Gresik Regency in supporting the Development of East Java Province, which is also an integrity of National Development; therefore, the time and color it possesses are in accordance with National Development.

Regarding the factors that influence the success rate in this Basic Pattern, the influence is described and needs to be taken into account in its Development Planning.

With the establishment of the Basic Pattern of Regional Development into a Regional Regulation, the following consequences will follow:

1. Regional government officials are obliged to use the Basic Pattern of Regional Development as a basis for coordination in the implementation of Regional Development programs.
2. It binds the people and the community of Gresik Regency to participate together in the implementation of Regional Development.
3. If the Broad Outlines of State Policy is a statement and political decision that has become a national decree, then this Basic Pattern of Development also functions as a statement and political decision as a crystallization of the will of the government and the people of Gresik Regency, which will be implemented in the sixth PELITA of the Regency of Gresik.
